In its October 30, 2015, *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM)* in the above-referenced dockets, the Commission proposes to require the registration of Hearing Aid Compatible (HAC) Customer Premises Equipment (CPE) used with VoIP service in a public database, such as the database of terminal equipment that is administered by the Administrative Council for Terminal Attachments (ACTA).¹ The ACTA supports this proposal and believes the ACTA maintained database could be modified to accommodate the registration of this equipment.
