Commissioner Crumpton has asked me to give members of NARUC's Committee on Finance and Technology periodic updates on significant developments in telecommunications standards work. I'm pleased to send you the latest edition of our report on leading edge telecommunications standards work and the strategic plan which drives the work of our Committee T1. The technologies included in this report will form the roadbed for the information highway and are in various stages of evolutionary development.

Of particular interest, work is nearly complete on a set of air interface standards critical to the development of the personal communications industry.

In addition to producing one standard or technical report a week, Committee T1 also makes more than 1,000 contributions a year to the United States State Department for use in standards issues before the International Telecommunication Union. The Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions and Committee T1 also are playing important roles in the work of the Information Infrastructure Standards Panel created last year by the American National Standards Institute to ensure rapid deployment of the national and global information infrastructures.

I am also enclosing a copy of the 1994 Annual Report from Committee T1. The report by Chairman Arthur K. Reilly gives a good overview of the standards work being fostered by Committee T1. The individual reports by the Technical Subcommittee leaders gives more specifics on the benefits of the many standards and technical reports developed during 1994.
